“1 Kings”

- ▶ Adonijah vies for throne with Solomon
 - Joab & Abiathar
 - Zadok, Benaiah, Nathan, Shimei, Rei
- ▶ David makes Solomon King
 - Put on King David’s mule
 - Gihon Spring
- ▶ King David Dies
 - Last commands to Solomon
 - Be a good and strong leader
 - Obey the Lord your God by following the commands written in the teachings of Moses
 - “Deal” with Joab & Shimei
 - Show kindness to Barzillai
 - Solomon’s cleansing

“1 Kings”

- ▶ Solomon asks for Wisdom
 - Kingdom
 - West of Euphrates to Philistines
 - “During Solomon’s life, all of his people were able to sit under their own fig trees and grapevines”
 - Greater than wisdom of East or wisdom in Egypt
- ▶ Builds Temple
 - Began 480 years after Exodus from Egypt
 - The Lord to “live among Israelites” in Temple
 - 7 years to build
- ▶ Solomon’s Palace
 - 13 years to build
 - Hall of Justice

“1 Kings”

- ▶ Ark Brought into Temple
 - “Most Holy Place”
 - Contents of Ark
 - Filled with the “Glory of the Lord”
- ▶ Solomon’s prayer
 - Covenantal (22–30); Grace (37–40); Agent of Blessing (41–43)
- ▶ Lord appears to Solomon
- ▶ Queen of Sheba visits Solomon
- ▶ Solomon’s wealth
- ▶ Solomon’s downfall
 - 700 wives; 300 concubines
- ▶ Ahijah the Shilonite
 - Tore new coat into 12 pieces
- ▶ Solomon’s death

“1 Kings”

- ▶ Divided Monarchy
 - Rehoboam
 - Jeroboam I
 - Golden Calves – Dan & Bethel
- ▶ Prophecy against Bethel
- ▶ Prophecy against House of Jeroboam I (Ahijah)
 - Caused Israel to sin
- ▶ Prophecy against House of Baasha (Jehu)
- ▶ Elijah the Tishbite
 - Stops the rain
 - Widow at Zarephath
 - Kills prophets of Baal
 - Runs Away

- ▶ Elisha becomes a prophet
- ▶ Naboth's vineyard
- ▶ Death of Ahab
